

MANAGING WORK IN CONFINED SPACES

To impart knowledge and skills to those persons who may be involved in planning, organizing and managing work safely in confined spaces.

This training programme is designed for those responsible for organizing and planning work activities within a confined space. The manager may or may not supervise the actual job. (Emphasis on hazards / controls, use of documents associated with confined space entries, use of environmental monitoring equipment, access equipment, escape breathing apparatus.)

If a City and Guilds certificate is required then an actual work base project must be undertaken and assessed.
